Updated statement from Anglo American, Isaac Regional Council, Mining & Energy Union, Electrical Trades Union, Collieries Staff and Officials Association and Australian Manufacturing Workers Union

5 July 2024

Industry-first working group supports workforce and community

We are making significant progress in the temporary sealing of Grosvenor Mine and stabilising the emergency response. Grosvenor Mine is a significant employer in the Moranbah region, and we recognise its positive impact reaches far beyond the mine gates.

We've established an industry-first working group consisting of senior leaders from Anglo American Steelmaking Coal and senior representatives from all unions covering the company's operations in Queensland. The group's objective is to support the long-term sustainability of the Grosvenor Mine workforce.

We are committed to working together to create continuous job opportunities and minimise uncertainty for our impacted workforce by sharing expertise and developing options for addressing these challenges.

Significant progress has already been achieved since the incident. Today, we are pleased to confirm payment extension from 15 July to 31 August for all employees and embedded contractors working full-time at Grosvenor in operations or staff roles. Our priority is to provide added security for the Grosvenor workforce while we fully stabilise the mine to then begin assessing all options going forward.

Within this time, we will be able to understand the ongoing permanent workforce requirements at Grosvenor Mine and the potential internal redeployment opportunities available at other Anglo American operations, including the open-cut operations and/or Brisbane Corporate Office.

We will also continue to collaborate with industry peers to prioritise employment opportunities for impacted employees and contractors across the Bowen Basin and NSW (working with the Minerals Council of Australia (MCA), Minerals Council of NSW, and Queensland Resources Council (QRC) over the coming weeks).

This significant program of work demonstrates our commitment to ensuring safety and stability at Grosvenor Mine and providing ongoing certainty for the impacted workforce.

We will provide regular updates from the working group as available.
